

FISHERIES DEPARTMENT OF TTAADC.

The Fisheries wing of TTAADC is playing a vital role with its limited Budgeting provision for enhancing Fish production by adopting different kind of beneficiaries oriented scheme such as distribution of Fish seed & inputs etc including distribution of Nets to the poor tribal fish farmers.

The extensions of water area are also being created with its limited fund for increasing the production of fish in its area. A very limited provision of fund is also kept in the Budget for upkeepment of created assets.

The training programme of fish farmers are also being organized in different Sub Zonal sectors for up gradation of skill and to train up the technical know-how towards the poor tribal fish farmers.

The staff of Fisheries wing also being engaged for the works other than fisheries as and when authorities felt necessary. Some times while fund is received from special Programme in the same way the field level staff are also engaged for the achievement.

Presently there are 3(three) Nos. of Fish Farm under the control of 2 (two) ZDO`s namely 1) Belbari Fish Farm, 2) Khumulwng Fish Farm & 3) Garjee Fish Farm and having water area 1.72 hac, 4.20 hac. & 1.50 hac. respectively.

The Budgetary provision for the Fisheries wing is Rs. 42.00 Lakhs only for the current

Presently the execution system adopted is that fund, a is being placed to the respective ZDO`s for any kind of implementation of scheme after obtaining approval from the authority. The staff of Fisheries wing posted under the disposal of ZDO`s implement the works if ordered by the ZDO`s. In addition recently State Fisheries Department, Govt. of Tripura has transferred 4 (four) Nos. establishment i.e 1. O/O the S.F, Kanchanpur, 2 . O/O the S.F, Longtarai Valley, 3. O/O the S.F, Gandacherra and 4. O/O the S.F, Jatanbari under disposal to the P.O (Fisheries),TTAADC. Where all the ongoing works are being done by the them as per Annual and Action Plan of Fisheries Department as guided by the Department.

The ADC also joined hand in formulating the programme in its area for production of Fish towards achieving the self sufficiency in the State by 2010-11.
