## **Name of schemes and briefly Guideline under Social Welfare & Social Education, TTAADC as on 31<sup>st</sup> December,2020**

The Social Welfare & Social Education Department in TTAADC started its journey in 1986 with 474 numbers of transferred Social Education Centres having 385 Jr. SEO & 270 School Mothers. Subsequently the TTAADC also appointed 10 nos Social Education Organizer (SEO), 360 Jr. SEO and 348 School Mother.

On 1<sup>st</sup> July' 2007, the management of the Social Education Centres was taken aback by the State Government. Again in the month November of 2010, the State Government handed over the management of 6 ICDS projects namely- 1) Kanchanpur, 2) Damcherra & 3) Jampuihill under North District of TTAADC and 4) Manu, 5) Chawmanu & 6) Dumburnagar under Dhalai District of TTAADC.

### **Name of schemes and brief Guideline under Social Welfare & Social Education, TTAADC as on 31<sup>st</sup> December,2020 as follows:**

#### **A. Schemes under Transfer fund (Central & State sponsored scheme):**

1. **Supplementary Nutrition Programme (SNP):** Nutrition has been provided to the children of 6 months to 6 years and pregnant and nursing mothers for supplementary nutritional support. Total 43832 children out of 43832 enrolled were provided SNP while total 8302 mothers out of 8302 enrolled (pregnant/nursing) were covered during the current year 2020-21.

The ministry of Women & Child Development, govt of India has taken a major challenge to combat the mal-nourished child and an anaemic mother by fashion of "**Poshan Abhiyan**" under National Nutrition Mission for 3 (three) years commencing from 2016. ICDS projects of TTAADC are actively taking part in it covering North & Dhalai districts considered to be most backward in the state. In it, various non-formal activities are undertaken to make child friendly.

2. **PMMVY (Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandhana Yujna):** Pregnant and Nursing mothers of two children are being provided conditional money benefit @ Rs. 5000/- per mother in 3 installments under Central Scheme from the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018. This scheme aims at mothers for awareness and imparts the importance of Nutritional, Immunization and projection of nuclear family to be a happy family. A total of 12133 mothers had been covered upto Dec'2020 under this scheme (5390 in 1<sup>st</sup> inst. @Rs.1000/-; 4312 in 2<sup>nd</sup> inst., @Rs.2000/- & 2431 in 3<sup>rd</sup> inst., @Rs.2000/).

3. **Scheme for Adolescent Girls (SAG):** This scheme has two parts namely- **Nutrition & Non-Nutrition component** for the Adolescent Girls under the age of 11 to 14 years those who are Out of School. Through nutrition component, Take Home Ration (THR) is being provided to the Adolescent Girls. A total number of 362 out of 362 enrolled AGs in 6 ICDS Projects, TTAADC were covered during the financial year 2020-21. On other hand, the non-nutrition component aims to socially encouraging & empowering to Adolescent Girls through various activities like Sakhi Saheli trainings, life skill education, NHE programme etc.

4. **Social Security Pension:** Financial assistance provided to 26813 pensioners under 30 various schemes through ECS model administered by the Directorate, SW&SE, Govt of Tripura during **2020-21** out of which 12350 beneficiaries were under NSAP scheme and 14463 beneficiaries under State run schemes covering 6 ICDS projects administered by the TTAADC under North & Dhalai Districts.

5. **LPG & Internet connection in AWCs:** Recently LPG connectivity to 472 Nos. Anganwadi Centres under ICDS Projects of TTAADC were provided under this innovation of **Poshan Abhiyaan** during 2020-21 & target has been taken to cover the rest 778 Nos. Anganwadi Centres during 2020-21. In other recent steps is the internet connectivity provided to all Anganwadi Workers and Supervisors-ICDS for real time monitoring under CAS, ICT-RTM who have been provided Smart phones under this innovation of Poshan Abhiyaan.

**6. Tripura Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Abhiyaan:** This is a scheme newly introduced on 08.07.2020 by the State government which a multi sector intervention state scheme. In order of compliance, SW&SE, TTAADC has taken an initiative to follow the order where as many as 500 girls have been targeted during 2021-22 in North & Dhalai Districts of TTAADC.

**B. Schemes under Transfer Grant (State sponsored scheme):** On receipt of fund from State Govt., we prepared an action plan for various development activities especially on development of women and children as follows:

**1. Incentive training to SAG (Scheme for Adolescent Girls):** - Special training was given through the resource persons for incentive training to AGs under 16-18 years (Out of School) under SAG every year. This training was provided for different trades in different ICDS projects. 84 AGs were covered in the scheme and benefited during 2019-20. Equipments like tailor machine etc were also provided to AGs after successful completion of the training. A total number of 124 AGs (64 + 64) are also targeted to benefit them during the F/Y year of 2020-21 & 2021-22.

**2. Observance of Special Days:** - Various special days like International Literacy day, Children day etc were observed in every year to aware the rural women and mothers on health education and encourage the children to take part in educational activities/quiz and games. This year total 14 programmes such as **Children Day-7 nos** and **Literacy Day- 7 nos** were observed during 2020-21.

**3. Construction of Kitchen Shed:** 13 nos. construction of pucca kitchen shed have been undertaken during 2020-21. As many as 35 Kitchen shed are also targeted during 2021-22 to be constructed under 6 (six) ICDS projects in North & Dhalai District, TTAADC.

**5. Maintenance of AWCs:** ICDS as an integral part of education and nurturing of children and mothers, proper infrastructure is basically important. Keeping this in mind, the department took efforts to maintain/repair as many as 120 AWCs during this year covering 6-ICDS projects under North & Dhalai District, TTAADC. As many as 130 AWCs are under target taken during 2021-22.

**6. Incentive Training to Adolescent Girls (AGs):-** This is a scheme that look upon generating self employed by imparting them a training through registered agencies. During 2021-22, 8 units have been taken into account for implementation.

**7. Establishment of Model AWC:-** Model AWC is a initiative taken under the direct guidance of the Principal Officer, SW&SE, TTAADC in generating more fruitful way of imparting pre-School education in AWCs by providing various materials like , school bags, water bottle, shoes, shocks etc. During 2021-22, 60 Anganwadi Centres are taken into account for implementation of such models.

**8. Capacity building training to Anganwadi Workers:-** Every year few identified workers who are weaker in promoting ICDS services are being trained covering 6-ICDS projects of North & Dhalai Districts under TTAADC. During 2021-22, a total number of 12 units are taken into account for implementation of such models.

**9. Chwrai Sakham(a programme for healthy child):-** A noble project initiated by TTAADC for providing the essentials requirement of a child like free medicines, nutritional food. It aims at overall growth of a child and mother who are financially poor among the tribal population of TTAADC area covering 6-ICDS projects. During 2021-22, a total number of 50 children have been targeted for implementation.

**10. Award:** The Department of Social Welfare & Social Education TTAADC had taken a special step to encourage the ICDS functionaries by awarding every year to the best performers among Anganwadi Worker, Anganwadi Helper, Supervisor(ICDS) and the project organized during the financial year 2020-21.

**11. Observance of Old Age Day:-** International Day for Elderly is celebrated every year on 1st October. This day is observed to focus on the importance of senior citizens who sometimes are neglected in our society. This day emphasizes on our responsibilities towards our elder in order to make their lives happier. As many as 11 programmes have been targeted in 6-ICDS projects & 5-ZDOs, TTAADC in each year during the year of 2020-21 & 2021-22.

**C. Schemes under Plan Fund (TTAADC own scheme):** On the basis of fund receipt from TTAADC, various development activities especially on development of women and children including senior citizen were also conducted as follows:

**1. Financial Aid to Orphan Child:** The Department of SW&SE, TTAADC has taken an initiative to extend in providing financial aid to orphan child belonging to tribals under TTAADC. A total target for the year 2021-22 is Rs. 5.29 for 5 units to be implemented by the ZDOs of North & Dhalai Tripura.

**2. Observance of Baby show:** This is an activity where a programme is being organized for children & mothers who shall participate for baby show and in turn special price would be given to them under few conditional criteria like full immunization etc. at all Anganwadi Centres of TTAADC.

**3. Observance of Anti Dowry Programme:** Awareness on Anti-Dowry programme is being organized by the ZDOs and CDPOs by involving Anganwadi Workers and other PRI representatives.

**4. Financial Assistance to Helpless Senior Citizen:** This scheme aims at enhancing senior citizen to help them support themselves with micro financially. In many cases such vulnerable old aged citizens often becomes the victim of negligence. A total number of 65 nos are taken under target during 2021-22.

**5. Financial Assistance to Self Help Group (SHG):** This scheme aims at financially, supporting SHG among tribal population under TTAADC. There are 6 units targeted during 2021-22.

**6. Providing of community base Growth Chart at AWCs:** Community based Growth Chart (picture of animals, flowers, alphabets etc) are being provided in 1250 AWCs under 6 ICDS Projects, TTAADC for the financial year 2021-22.

**7. Distribution of hygienic articles like Hand wash, Mask, soap, hand sanitizer etc:** As a preventive measures hand wash, sanitizer etc are being taken into consideration to provide to the children of Anganwadi Centres of TTAADC.

**8. Awareness programme on Covid-19:-** The CDPOs of TTAADC shall conduct an awareness programme on Covid-19 where various activities such as imparting education & knowledge of taking care of self sustaining.
